Day-to-day clinical work is grounded in formal quality and safety governance: I serve on my hospital's Serious Safety Event classification, Mortality Review, and Sepsis committees — the institutional bodies that adjudicate standard of care, analyze adverse outcomes, and perform root-cause review — and regularly precept physician assistant students. This governance- and teaching-level scrutiny of clinical decision-making is the same analysis that medicolegal record review and standard-of-care consulting require.
